




## Assembling your chart

- Open the Print dialog (File > Print)
- Print all pages
- Lay page A onto solid surface
- Cut page B along TOP margin
- Paste page B to bottom of page A
- If you have a 'colour in' chart, give to your child to colour in.








## STEP 2 Preparing your character
